Paul R. Weise became the Director of the Office of Geospatial Intelligence Management (OGM) in June 2009. In that capacity, he manages resources that constitute and support the National System for Geospatial Intelligence (NSG) and oversees NSG strategic planning, functional and program guidance, and architecture analysis. In addition, Mr. Weise leads the NSG requirements process, which identifies, coordinates, and formally documents geospatial intelligence (GEOINT) requirements that are validated by the Department of Defense's Joint Requirements Oversight Council and the Office of the Director of National Intelligence's Mission Requirements Board. Mr. Weise is responsible for assessing GEOINT programs and functional performance within the National Intelligence and Military Intelligence Programs. He also oversees planning, modeling, and simulation for future GEOINT systems and capabilities.



Prior to his appointment to OGM, Mr. Weise served as the Director, Office of Corporate Communications (OCC), and was responsible for Congressional liaisons, public affairs, agency history, and customer communication. Mr. Weise has also served in NGA's Analysis & Production Directorate, NGA's largest office, and was responsible for supporting civilians, government agencies, policymakers, and our armed forces deployed around the globe by directing innovative geospatial intelligence discovery, development, and production. Mr. Weise's previous assignments include serving as NGA's Senior representative to the National Security Agency; Deputy Director of the GEOSCOU Program Office; Deputy Director of the Asia Pacific Office; Director of the Commercial Partnerships Office and Commercial Imagery Program; Deputy Director of the Digital Products Department; Chief, DMA's Advanced Weapons and Systems Division; Middle East Regional and Terrain issues analyst; and in DMA's Office of Europe/National Alliance Treaty Organization Affairs. Mr. Weise began his career at the Defense Mapping Agency (DMA) Hydrographic/Topographic Center in March 1980 as a Cartographer.

Mr. Weise earned a Bachelors Degree in Geography with a focus in Environmental Science in 1979 from Edinboro State College. He completed his Masters Degree in Information Systems in 1992 at the University of Maryland. He attended the Federal Executive Institute's "Leadership in a Democratic Society", the Intelligence Community's "Fellows" Program, and the Harvard and Kellogg Executive Leadership Program. Mr. Weise earned the Meritorious Civilian Service Award in 1998 and the Presidential Rank Award in 2009.
