



Universal GEOINT Certification Governance Board Seeks Nominees

The Universal GEOINT Certification Governance Board (CGB), an advisory body to USGIF and its Universal GEOINT Certification Program, seeks nominees with a background in government and/or industry to serve as members. The CGB comprises a variety of background and perspectives relevant to the GEOINT community. The CGB is responsible for all of the program's essential certification decisions, including reviewing and approving the development and ongoing maintenance of all program policies, procedures, and content, and provides guidance and structure to the vision and marketing of the program. The Universal GEOINT Certification Program includes four certifications, three of which were recently accredited by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies.

CGB membership is drawn from the following populations:

- Subject Matter Experts in the technologies and products being developed and introduced in the GEOINT market
- Representatives from major industry and academic sectors that employ GEOINT practitioners and analysts
- Senior Human Capital and/or Human Resources officials from major employers

All selected CGB members must have at least five (5) years of professional GEOINT work experience, as well as work experience across multiple GEOINT domains. The CGB meets at least three (3) times annually with meetings occurring both in-person and via teleconference.
