This form serves to document your progress in maintaining your Certified GEOINT Professional (CGP™) certification. Per the Certification Maintenance Policy, you can maintain your certification by either obtaining the required number of Professional Development Units (PDUs) as stated in the Candidate Handbook or take and pass a USGIF-Sponsored Certification. To comply with the Policy, you are required to complete the Certification Maintenance Form (CMF) and send it to credential@usgif.org no later than the three (3) year anniversary of conferral of your most recent certification.

The [Candidate Handbook](#) is an available resource documenting the requirements, and examples of Professional Development Units (PDUs) candidates are to allocate the appropriate number of PDUs for a given activity.

Audits will be conducted on a random basis to ensure the continuing maintenance of your certification. By submitting and signing this form, you agree to provide supporting documentation upon request for audit. The CGP™ Program Management Office strongly encourages candidates to retain all documentation related to PDU credit. It is your professional responsibility as a holder of a CGP™ certification to maintain appropriate documentation of your PDUs. Failure to provide the necessary documentation is sufficient grounds for certification expiration and/or revocation.

Please submit your completed form to credential@usgif.org no later than the three (3) year anniversary of conferral of your most recent certification. If your certification is randomly selected for audit, you will be notified by the CGP™ Program Management Office.
