



### **Speaker Tips**

Remember that your conversation is with the audience, not only with the MC or other speakers. Please remember to face the audience, even when you are responding to (or forming) a question or comment from the MC. Try to project to the middle or back of the audience.

If you are presenting on a panel, please remember to share speaking time with the other panelists. Feel free to weigh in on each other's questions and answers to make it a more conversational flow.

Please be mindful of your use of acronyms—while many in the audience have a basic understanding of common industry terms (i.e. ML/AI), it will help others to learn if you can remind people what the associated acronyms mean.

You have been asked to join the panel as thought leaders in the field. Please do not use this as an opportunity to promote your company or its proprietary solutions.
